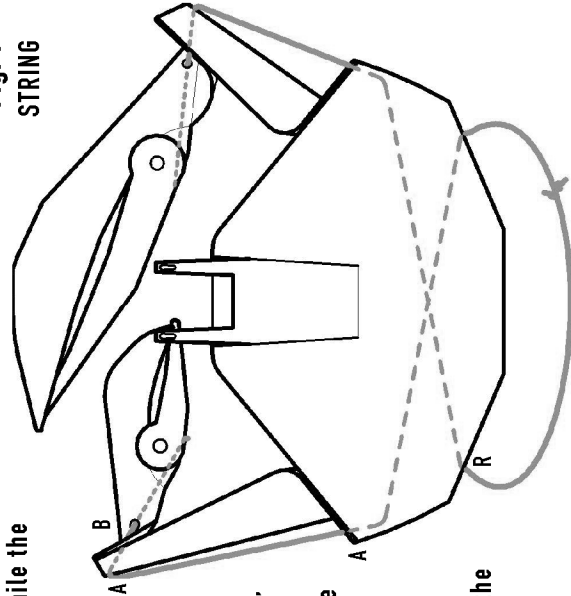


CONTROLLING THE CRAB!

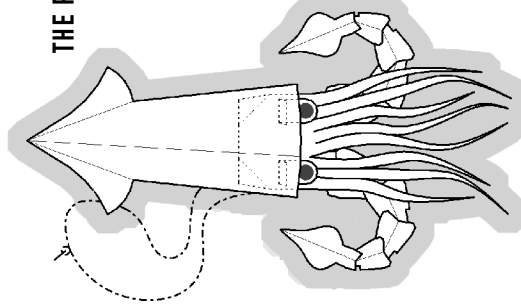
- Pulling on the left side of the string works the right claw while the right side works the left claw.
- Pull out, rather than back on the strings for smoother functioning.
- TIP: If the crab seems sluggish, tighten the rubber bands: Pull on an end knot and then tie another knot lower down the rubber band. If this creates adequate tension, snip the old knot off. If it does not, repeat the previous step until it does.

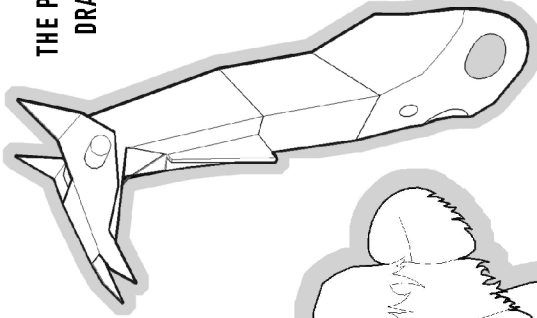


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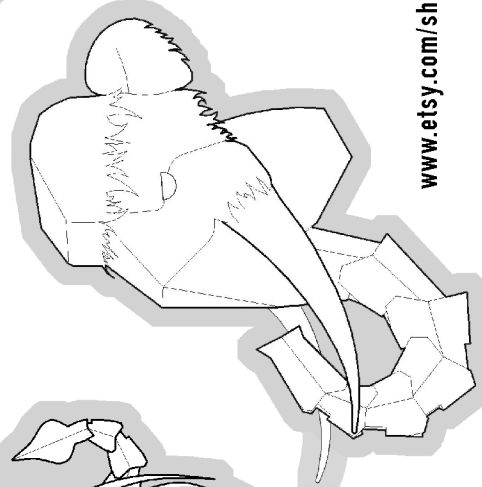
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Fig. 1 ANATOMY OF

WHAT YOU GET:

- 2 SHEETS OF PARTS
- 2 RUBBER BANDS (LATEX FREE)
- 2 LENGTHS OF STRING
- 1 PIECE OF WIRE
- 2 WOODEN DOWELS

WHAT YOU NEED:

- SCISSORS
- HOBBY KNIFE
- WHITE GLUE
- RULER
- SCORING TOOL

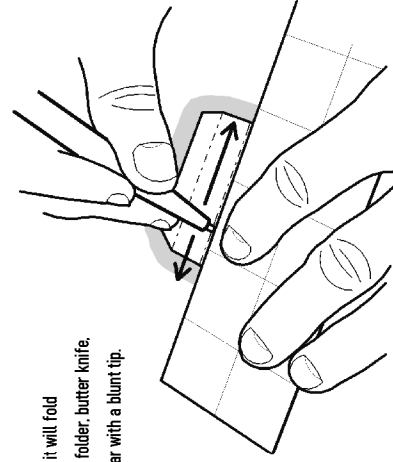
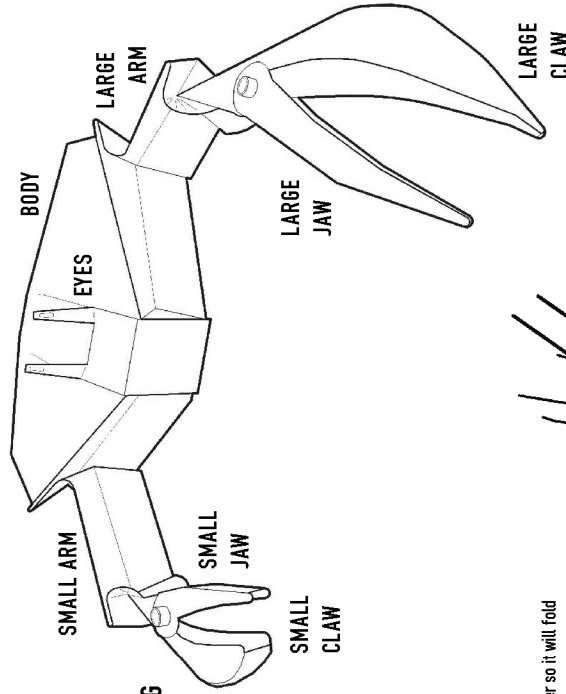


Fig. 2 USING A

A scoring tool compresses the paper so it will fold neatly along the scored line. Use a bone folder, butter knife, ballpoint pen gone dry or anything similar with a blunt tip. Use a ruler as a guide to make score lines straight (see Fig. 2)
