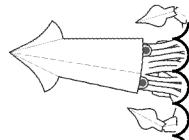


CONTROLLING THE SQUID!

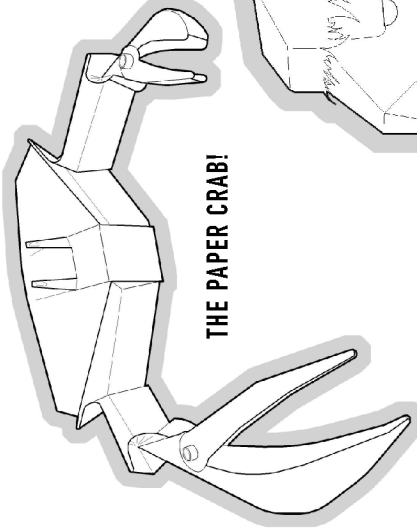
- Place the middle and index fingers of one hand into the holes indicated on the model.
- Smaller hands can switch the middle finger for the ring finger.
- Pull STRAIGHT UP on the loop of string with the other hand to work both tentacles at once.
- Pull up on one side of the loop to work one tentacle at a time.
- The squid can grab light objects.
- TIP: If the squid seems sluggish, tighten the rubber bands by tying another knot 1/4" below knot #2 and lodging this knot back into the slot marked 'L'.

THE BABY SQUIDS! (finger puppets)

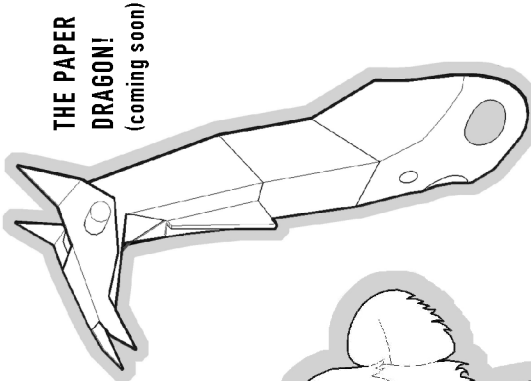
- Score and cut out.
- Shape the mantle by gently rolling the squid around your finger.
- Fold the body up into the mantle according to the lines.
- Curl the arms.
- Glue the tab so the mantle makes a finger sized loop.



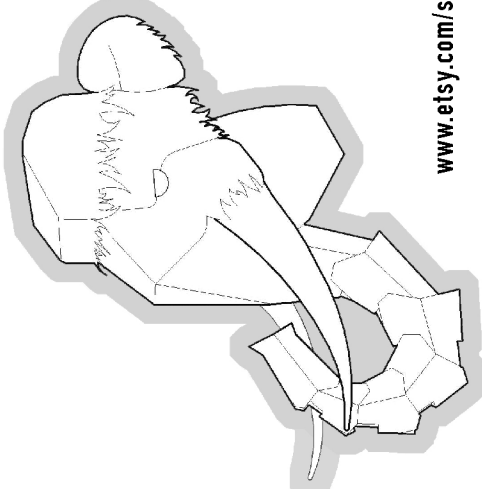

WHAT YOU GET:

- 3 SHEETS OF PARTS
- 2 RUBBER BANDS (LATEX FREE)
- 1 LENGTH OF STRING
- 1 PIECE OF WIRE

WHAT YOU NEED:

- SCISSORS
- WHITE GLUE
- RULER
- SCORING TOOL

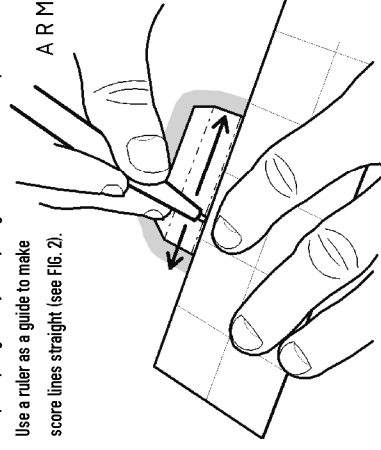


Fig. 2 USING A SCORING TOOL

A scoring tool compresses the paper so it will fold neatly along the scored line. Use a bone folder, butter knife, ballpoint pen gone dry or anything similar with a blunt tip. Use a ruler as a guide to make score lines straight (see FIG. 2).
